

WORK CAPACITY EVALUATION (WCE)

What is it?

A combined vocational and functional evaluation designed to determine the extent of the client's ability to safely perform relevant work tasks. The evaluation is in two parts and takes place over one day. It covers;

- Occupational profile (interests, ability and aptitude)
- Transferrable work experience and skill set
- Functional and cognitive capacity for work
- Identifies a structured vocational rehabilitation plan



Who is it for?

A service for clients no longer employed following an accident. The evaluation will determine their safe functional and vocational capacity for work. It is also for client's who are unsure what occupational direction may be suitable following an accident.

The evaluation is usually conducted either as part of an ongoing rehabilitation programme or as a precursor to establishing the direction of a potential vocational rehabilitation support programme.

What does the service offer?

- A bespoke objective vocational and functional evaluation
- A clinical assessment of mobility, postural tolerances and fitness and endurance
- An assessment of factors such as pain, psychological, social, vocational or educational issues
- A concise report detailing findings and impact of current functional and vocational ability on work activities
- Recommendations for suitable job options to aid the client reengage with work, if appropriate
- Vocational Rehabilitation recommendations for assistance in enabling and assisting the client overcome barriers towards moving closer to reengaging with appropriate work roles
